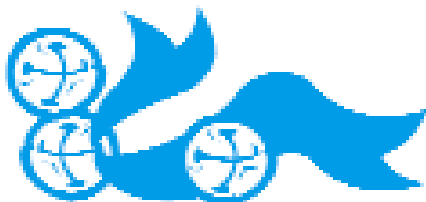

We had several campers who were here for the first time and it was heartwarming to watch the seasoned veterans taking them under their wing, showing them around and telling them what a great place camp is. It is apparent that word of camp has been spreading since we have many new participants and each month's camp has been filled to capacity.

The weekend was filled with activities that provided something for everyone. The theme of "We have a responsibility to thank God for the many gifts He has given us" was explored during a teaching and discussion group where each person had an opportunity to share their thoughts on what they were thankful for. 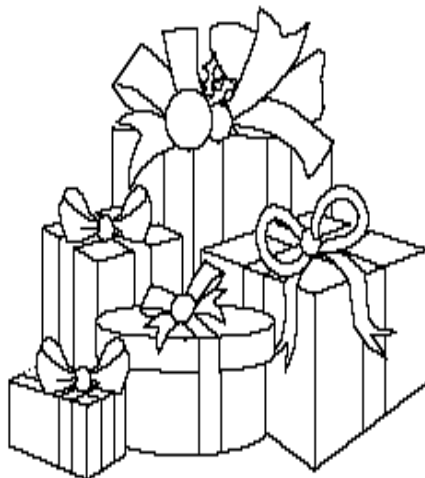

PLANNED GIVING CENTER

Charitable Remainder Trusts—Part Two: Annuity Trusts

Last month in this column we outlined the benefits of the charitable remainder unitrust—a trust designed to receive a person’s assets and make variable lifetime annual payments equal to a percentage of the fair market value of trust assets, determined annually. In our example we discussed a donor scenario in which Mr. Bennett, 65 years old and a business owner, wanted to make a donation to Share Foundation while still receiving a life income from his business. By setting up a charitable remainder unitrust, we showed how Mr. Bennett could transfer his business into the trust, generate additional income for himself, receive an income-tax deduction, avoid capital gains tax, and make a deferred gift to Share Foundation!

The charitable remainder **annuity trust** is another type of trust also designed to receive a person’s assets subject to the trustee paying fixed annual income for life that is equal to at least 5 percent of the initial net fair market value of the trust at the time the assets were delivered to the trustee. The primary difference between the unitrust and the annuity trust is the determination of the annual percent rate. With unitrusts, payments (income) are determined by the fair market value of trust assets determined annually whereas annuity trusts pay an annual life income at a fixed rate of at least 5 % of the initial net fair market value. Consider this example of a donor setting up an annuity trust to meet their life income needs while also leaving a legacy to the Share Foundation:

Situation: Mr. and Mrs. O’Malley, ages 74 and 69, own appreciated stocks valued at 20 times the original cost when purchased 10 years ago, and to date, they have not received any dividends. The O’Malley’s would not only like to increase their retirement income, but they would also like to make a gift to the Share Foundation when they die.

Solution: The O’Malley’s can transfer their stock into a charitable remainder annuity trust to pay a percentage of the initial net fair market value of the stock annually.

Benefits: Let’s say that at the time of the stock transfer, the O’Malley’s set up their trust to pay 7% of the initial fair market value of the stock annually. By doing so they are able to:

- Make a gift to the Share Foundation at death
- Avoid capital gains tax now
- Receive an income-tax deduction now for the present value of the charitable remainder interest
- Exchange a non-income-producing asset for a fixed percentage annual income for the life of both of them!

Charitable remainder annuity trusts are just another example of how planned gifts can and should be a win-win situation. We encourage you to consult your financial planner or tax adviser when making decisions regarding your investments and estate plan.
