The word "impossible" is not an Irish word.

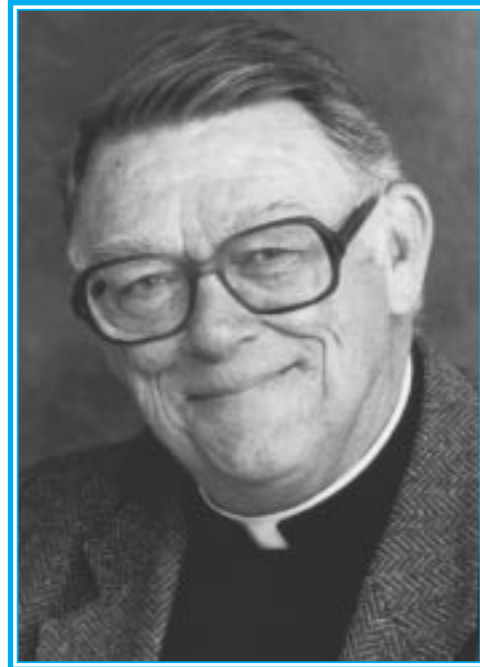

THOUGHTS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

A couple of years ago, one of our stewards was driving several Villagers to a store in a neighboring town. A relief steward, who was new to our program, was also with them. When they reached their destination, there wasn't a parking place to be found so they drove around for a few minutes looking for an open space. The relief steward spotted a handicapped parking space and suggested they use that one. The driver replied, "we can't park there" but the relief steward persisted in asking why not? Before the steward could answer, the Villager who was sitting in the front seat turned around and announced, "Because we're not handicapped, we're other abled!" Sounds like a good answer to me! I know I couldn't have said it better myself.

This story is especially appropriate as we celebrate Disabilities Awareness Month in March since the theme this year is **ABILITY – No matter how you spell it**. Becoming more aware of people with disabilities must start with becoming more aware of all people. Like everyone else, people with disabilities just want to be accepted for who they are. Focus on the person and their abilities – what they are able to do – and value them for who they are. Having certain needs like a special parking place or someone to drive them to the store doesn't change a person, it just makes their needs different from others. Most of us need someone else to cut our hair or change the oil in our car and those needs don't make us a different person. We need each other and the world needs all of us.

Share Foundation has always used the term "other abled" to focus on the positive aspect of what we are able to do. Hearing that a Villager proudly stated, "We're not handicapped. We're other abled!" reminded me what a high-quality term it is and I'm proud to use it. March may be the month that's officially designated as "Disabilities Awareness" but at Sharing Meadows, we celebrate and give thanks for each other's abilities each and every day.

Our Villagers are comfortable with who they are and they know they have strengths and weaknesses like everyone else and they recognize that they are valued for their uniqueness. The Villagers realize that they're not perfect but, come to think of it, neither am I!
