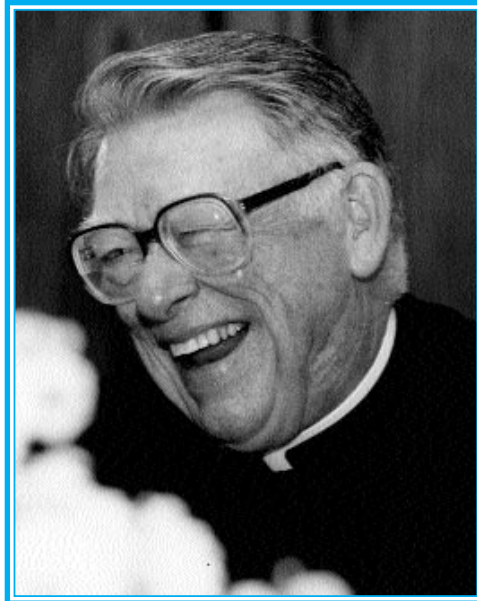

THOUGHTS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Camp. It's a simple word but when we're referring to Camp Sharing Meadows at the St. Timothy Center it's anything but simple. Our camp is lively, exhilarating, meaningful, and joyful. People – campers and staff alike – are valued for who they are and everyone's unique gifts are recognized and appreciated. Traditional camp activities are available: campfires, arts & crafts, games, hiking, and swimming in our beautiful new pool but what sets our camp apart from all the others is the values that are stressed and encouraged during the daily teaching and discussion session centered around a specific theme that has been established for camp.

In the past, the theme was randomly selected each month but this year we decided to try something new by setting a general theme with a different focus each month. We selected the general theme of "Responsibility" and began at the September mini camp by talking about our responsibility to ourselves. All of the participants related to the idea which led to a lively discussion about our responsibility to keep ourselves healthy and use our talents to grow to become the person God created us to be. We read a passage from scripture that told the story of a man who gave three of his servants different amounts of money to take care of while he was away. Two of the servants doubled the money through wise investing while the third one buried it in the ground and could only return the original amount to his master when he returned. We agreed that we wanted to take responsibility for ourselves by making the most of our talents and grow to the best of our abilities. The discussion was followed by arts & crafts where everyone decorated a mirror in their own unique design to help them look into it and see the real person inside.

All of us need to be taken seriously and at Camp Sharing Meadows, the campers realize that their thoughts and feelings are valued and many profound statements are made during the discussion. It was good to see the theme so well received and we look forward to exploring our responsibility to our family at the October camp. In the coming months we will focus on other aspects of responsibility such as to our church, our job, and our community.

PLANNED GIVING CORNER

Securing the Future: Sharing Meadows Endowment Fund

Last year, Share Foundation celebrated its 20th anniversary! If you're saying to yourself, "I don't remember a 20th anniversary party," you're right—because we didn't have one. Instead, we prayed, reflected on our long history—sometimes rocky, always blessed—and decided to sow seeds for the next 20 years. The Sharing Meadows Endowment Fund, perhaps our greatest accomplishment yet, is in full force and effect.

The Sharing Meadows Endowment Fund is a significant marker in the history of our organization because it is the one vehicle by which we can secure our future. By establishing a separate and special fund for donations to the endowment, we can be sure that the residential community of Sharing Meadows and all of the programs that benefit the Villagers will go on in perpetuity. Gifts to the Endowment Fund are special because the principal amount of the donation is always preserved; only the interest from your gift will ever be used. Once the balance in the fund reaches a certain level, the steady stream of income produced will cover the general operating costs of the residential community. That means that the safety of the Villagers and their families' peace of mind will never be subject to an unstable economy or dependent on government funding.

And we have learned something else: donors believe in the endowment fund because of what it means for them too! Some of our contributions have come from those who believe that leaving a lasting legacy to honor their family name is more important than leaving behind a large estate over which they will have limited control. In fact, making a bequest by naming Share Foundation in your will is one way to ensure that what you valued in life will be carried on into eternity—it is a gift that represents your beliefs and commitment to our community. A gift to the endowment fund lasts a lifetime and beyond.

Contributions to the endowment fund can be made in the form of a bequest or any other number of ways. Donations in any amount from \$500 to multi-million dollar gifts can also take the form of cash, stock, life insurance, retirement plans or charitable remainder trusts, just to name a few. Some of these vehicles, as in the case of a charitable remainder trust, allow you to receive income from your investment as long as you are living with the remainder being invested in the endowment fund afterwards. With all major gifts, we encourage you to discuss your plans with an attorney or financial advisor so that you make an informed decision that manages your estate according to your desires and the best interest of you and your heirs.

Currently, there are two levels of recognition for gifts made to the endowment fund:

1982 Society—Eligible gifts in the amount of \$500-\$2499 Celebrates the date of incorporation for Share Foundation with the Handicapped, Inc.

1991 Society—Eligible gifts in the amount of \$2500 and up Celebrates the significance of the year of the 184-acre land purchase that is now Sharing Meadows

All contributions to the endowment fund will be reported in an annual special mailing. Donors who wish to remain anonymous and not have their gifts acknowledged publicly should simply let us know at the time the gift is made. In addition to acknowledgement in the honor roll of donors, members of the 1991 Society are invited to the Annual Dinner. Once again Sharing Meadows is opening its doors to the community by renting the St. Timothy Center camp building to any group of fifteen people or more for a weekend at Sharing Meadows. The building is available for one or two nights with as many meals as you desire served for your group. The meals can be chosen from a menu we will provide and the cost of the food is included in the rental price. Prices are determined based on number of nights spent and meals requested. There are four dormitories that comfortably sleep a total of 50 people on bunk beds. All features of the air conditioned building are available for the renter's use including a campfire pit, Tucker Lake with boats and fishing equipment, a stereo, a television with VCR, a piano, prayer stations and numerous tables and chairs.

The weekend rental is ideal for church groups, youth retreats, family reunions or any other group looking to spend time together in a peaceful environment. GENTLE TEACHING WORKSHOP

Thanks to a grant to Share Foundation from the Michigan City Community Enrichment Corporation, we are collaborating with Globestar to present a workshop on "**Gentle Teaching: Mentoring a Spirit of Gentleness.**" The three day workshop will take place at the St. Timothy Center at Sharing Meadows on October 22, 23 and 24. The first day will focus on basic principles of gentle teaching, the second day on innovative applications of gentle teaching within community, work and mentoring life; and the last day will show us how to implement gentle teaching within our organizations.

The workshop will be presented by John McGee, PhD, the founder of Gentle Teaching. He is recognized internationally for his advocacy for people who are marginalized. Gentle Teaching is based on a psychology of interdependence and focuses on the establishment of relationships based on mutual respect, love and valuing.
