Retirement Plans: Another Way to Give

We measure growth at Sharing Meadows in a number of ways including the improvement in our villagers' daily living skills and vocational abilities and also by the numbers of other-abled individuals we ultimately provide services for over time. Regardless of whether we are talking about improved self-sufficiency for individual other-abled adults or expansion of our programs and services, we have found that positive results can only come from planning wisely. Successfully planning a community for other-abled adults is not all that different from planning for your retirement—it requires clear goals, input from those we trust, and smart decisions along the way.

In 2004, Share Foundation will begin construction and development of the 3rd village in our residential community Sharing Meadows! That's exciting news considering the fact that our two existing villages, the Village of St. John and the Village of St. Vincent, have been at full capacity for some time, and our waiting list of prospective villagers keeps growing and growing. Just as we have carefully consulted with others and begun plans to realize this next phase of our dream, we would like for you to consult with your legal advisors and financial planners about ways in which designating Share Foundation as a beneficiary of your retirement plan can help us keep our dream alive forever, and help you meet at least three very important needs: (1) saving money, through tax deferral, while you are working; (2) creating a vehicle to save the amount of taxes your other heirs will have to pay on IRA distributions, for example; and (3) allowing you to leave a legacy by supporting the Share Foundation's work into eternity.

Here are answers to just a few frequently asked questions about charitable contributions through retirement plans:

What kinds of retirement plans are eligible?

Most employer-established plans that assist employees with their retirement planning and qualify under IRS regulations for the deferral of income taxes on contributions and investment earning until contributions are withdrawn, including pension plans, profit-sharing plans, ESPO, 401 (K) and Keogh plans, IRAs, SEPs, SIMPLE plans and 403(b) plans (tax sheltered annuities). Self-employed individuals can also establish some of these plans.

Why does naming Share Foundation as a beneficiary make sense? What about my other heirs?

Naming Share Foundation as the beneficiary of your retirement plan makes sense for some donors because as a tax-exempt organization, we do not have to pay income tax on the contribution we receive from your plan. Also, by specifying a percentage of your retirement plan assets rather than a fixed dollar amount, the size of your gift will invariably tend to grow.

By designating Share Foundation as your retirement plan beneficiary, you might then decide to leave the remainder of your assets to your other heirs for a more equitable distribution. For example, leaving \$10,000 in an IRA to one child and \$10,000 in stock to another child actually results in the second child receiving more value than the first. Why? Well, the first child has to pay income taxes on the IRA distribution whereas the second child will pay no income taxes on the stock.

How can I make Share Foundation a beneficiary?

It's easy, and very similar to designating a beneficiary of a life insurance policy. (See the July issue of *Good News* for details about life insurance policies as a vehicle for charitable giving). To designate Share Foundation as a beneficiary, simply fill out a new beneficiary form usually supplied by Human Resources or the retirement plan's investment manager/custodian. Remember to use your Employee Identification Number and to specify our exact name: Share Foundation with the Handicapped, Inc.

Do you want to take a break from the routine of your every day life? Are you looking to make new friends and share your faith in God with others? Are you tired of doing chores around the house during the weekends? Or maybe you just miss the taste of smores roasted over a campfire. If any of these scenarios sounds like you, you might make a perfect counselor for mini-camps here at Camp Sharing Meadows. All it takes to be a counselor is a caring spirit and an open heart; previous experience working with other-abled adults is not required. Just one weekend here gives counselors, cooks and nurses countless rewards from an experience they will never forget. Mini-camp provides other-abled adults an environment in which everyone is accepted and supported, a break from their normal routine that many campers look forward to each month.

We are hoping to staff the fall season of mini-camps as soon as possible, so don't miss out on the opportunity to share your love and fellowship with other-abled campers. Each weekend starts on Friday evening with an orientation at 6:00p.m. followed by the camper's arrival at 7:00p.m. Camp concludes at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoon. Room and board is provided, along with a \$50 grant. The dates for the Fall 2003 Mini-camps are:
