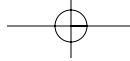
RENT THE ST. TIMOTHY CENTER FOR YOUR EVENT

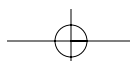


Andy Zepik and Paul Shafchuk share their musical talents at camp

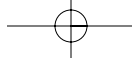
