## FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BLANEY...

### *Personhood:*

One of the philosophers said that we think, therefore we are. Well what about those who don't really think. Are they to be just tolerated?

Personhood is more than just thinking. A person is real irregardless of their thinking progress. A person develops their personhood thru relationships with other persons. A key to this development is acceptance.

In the Trinity there are three persons – God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. They are persons essentially because of relationship. That personhood is enhanced by the perfect acceptance in love of each other.

At Sharing Meadows, our residents (Villagers and Stewards) try to accept each other just as they are. They are

not primarily accepted because they play the piano well, or because they play a good game of basketball or because they can cut the grass well. They are accepted because they are a person who can be loved and related to.

The various activities at Sharing Meadows let them show their loveableness. It's their efforts at trying to do the job at hand, not the results, that bring about the relationship with each other. That is what Sharing Meadows is – living a community of loving acceptance that enhances each personhood.

Yes, we strive for a good job during the work day. A good looking rug or ceramic piece, a good feel to the walking stick, cut grass that looks neat, are all to be strived for and there is a certain amount of pride in a good
