FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BLANEY...

The sun was starting to set as the two weary travelers made their journey from Jerusalem down to Emmaus. Their shadows were getting longer, their conversations darker and their path more uncertain. Behind them were footsteps of a stranger that gradually caught up to them. And the stranger asked them what they were talking about so very solemnly. They couldn't believe that someone didn't know what had happened in Jerusalem: that Christ had been crucified. They were sure that He was the one to bring God's kingdom on earth. Now He is dead. They told of their dreams of marriage and school and now of their despair. All the things that they had hoped for like a good paying job and somehow had failed to find. They told of their loneliness, rejection, hopelessness. At a crossroads the stranger made as if going on, but the two encouraged him to join them at a simple meal. He showed them by retelling their stories, emphasizing the positive in their lives, they had developed with the rejection a great deal of patience. That loneliness had given them a craving to be with others. That through their hopelessness a realization that they needed to trust.

Now they were at a crossroads – filled with new possibilities of life – new choices. Loneliness gives way to community, despair to self-worth. This is what Sharing Meadows is!!! It's a short distance from Jerusalem to Emmaus – new hope from a place of less self worth.

The villagers at Sharing Meadows come seeking a new life in community. They are empowered to realize that there are far less limitations in their lives. That their lives are different in some ways than others but that doesn't make them less. In fact, in some ways the differences make them have great personalities. They, in fact, have a great gift to give to society – the gift of seeing others as a real person, not what the person does or others think

they do. Acceptance for the person we are – that is a great gift present at Sharing Meadows. Come on your life's journey, volunteer at Sharing Meadows! Your burdens will be lightened.

THOUGHTS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Last month the Villagers hosted a Super Bowl party at the St. Timothy Center. It was a joyful day of families and friends gathering together to share football, food and fellowship. The building was filled with laughter and conversation throughout the day. It was good to witness the pride the Villagers took in serving food and taking care of their guest's needs. They are comfortable at Sharing Meadows because they realize they are an integral part of the community.

I was reminded of their party when I received a packet of information about March being Disabilities Awareness month from the Indiana Governor's Planning Council for People With Disabilities. The theme for this year is **Freedom from Exclusion, Inclusion Now!** The Council has an assortment of posters, art projects, suggestions for special events, press releases and many activities suited for all ages to increase disability awareness and encourage inclusion in the community. Thinking about the theme of inclusion made me realize that Sharing Meadows is the ultimate in inclusion. Our Villagers share friendships, host parties, learn new skills and build their self-esteem by engaging in meaningful, productive work. They take pride in their homes and enjoy welcoming guests. Students from area schools come to Sharing Meadows because they enjoy spending time with our Villagers and the Villagers look forward to each visit. They spend time in the surrounding communities shopping, watching movies, bowling, worshipping at church, attending plays and musical productions, participating in Special Olympics, eating out, and singing for residents at two local nursing homes. Best of all, they do all of these things with each other, with their friends. They don't worry about inclusion because it's a way of life around here. They are happy because they are accepted for who they are and they enjoy fullness of life.

Some people look at inclusion as moving other abled people into apartments or homes in the center of cities. However, living in a populated area doesn't necessarily mean inclusion if the neighbors aren't friendly or welcoming. I look at our Villagers living in a rural community, not an urban area, but living with people who choose to live with them and find happiness by spending time together. Obviously there is a need to educate people about the giftedness of other abled people to encourage inclusion and Disabilities Awareness Month is a good place to start. My hope is that Sharing Meadows can serve as a model to others to show them that inclusion cannot become a reality without acceptance.

A few years ago I read a speech given by former White House press secretary James Brady and one of his points made such an impression on me, I wrote it on a card and keep it in my daily planner. He said, "We cannot direct the wind, but we can adjust the sails. We cannot make the sun rise, but we can enjoy the warmth of its rays. We cannot always eliminate a disability, but we can choose to accept that which cannot change and participate fully in life." Inclusion Now is happening at Sharing Meadows as all of us participate fully in life.
