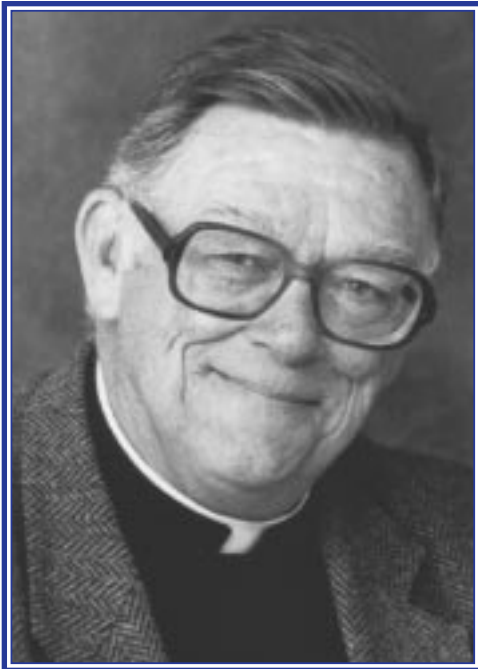

It's been 20 years since John and Beth Kearns started bringing their son, John Jr., to camp. At first, John Jr. was shy and withdrawn—he barely spoke to the other campers and sometimes he pleaded with the camp director to call his parents to pick him up early. Now 42 years old, John Jr. has outgrown his shyness over the years; in fact, it's usually John who starts the dancing off or leads the songs around the campfire! His parents have also noticed a difference in John's attitude over the years—he looks forward to camp, but even at home he is more outgoing and helpful. The Kearns family knows the difference Camp Sharing Meadows has made in their life and they want to be sure that other families have the same opportunity.*

Our Villagers look forward each and every year to participating in the Special Olympics. Each year they do quite well—often placing and bringing home medals. All year long they are focused on the competition. They practice long hours and they prepare themselves for the big day. But the best thing about Special Olympics is the way the event brings the Villagers together as a team representing Sharing Meadows. The Villagers know that everyone does not have the gift of the swift, but that doesn't stop them from cheering (loudly!) on their teammates, and giving out great victory hugs whatever the outcome may be.

This year we are building our 4th Village at Sharing Meadows. We can still remember when people tried to discourage us from ever beginning! Some said that building a community like Sharing Meadows would not work because it would be too expensive to operate or it would be too risky. We didn't let that stop us then and we aren't going to let those naysayers stop us now. There is a great need for private communities that cater to the social, vocational and residential needs of the other-abled. Our Villagers thrive because of the individualized attention they receive and the comprehensive care and services we provide. It is our mission to provide a safe and secure community for the other-abled where they can be respected. We intend to continue doing just that.

These are just a few examples of the ways Sharing Meadows has been able to change the lives of those we serve. Whether it be campers, parents, Villagers, or friends, Sharing Meadows has been the answer to so many prayers. We owe the success of our community to God and our loyal supporters—many of whom volunteer and make charitable contributions on a regular basis. If not for the support of donors at all levels—from \$5 to \$50,000—we recognize that our dream would be just that, a dream. We must find ways to keep our dream going, and bequests are one vehicle for doing so.

Bequests are an important and special expression of support for an organization. Bequests are significant gifts because they strengthen an organization's financial reserve.
