NAP CREDITS AWARDED TO SHARE FOUNDATION

Share Foundation is proud to be one of 70 organizations in the state of Indiana to be awarded tax credits through the Neighborhood Assistance Program. Funds raised will be used for the residential program at Sharing Meadows and donor's qualifying contributions can be counted as credits against their state tax liability. The NAP program is administered through the Indiana Department of Commerce's Community Development Division and focuses on supporting projects that benefit economically disadvantaged individuals and areas.

We have been awarded \$50,000 in tax credits to support our residential community. The NAP award brings increased awareness of Share Foundation's value to the community of other abled adults. Sharing Meadows has served as a role model to others as a way of providing a high quality of life for other abled people and we are happy that the state of Indiana has recognized our efforts.

For a minimum donation of \$1000, donors will receive a tax credit equal to 50% of their gift to be applied to the taxes due on their State of Indiana tax return. Gifts eligible for NAP credits include cash or stock, and can be made between now and June 1, 2005, or until the allotment of credits has been used. NAP credits will be distributed by Share Foundation on a first come, first served basis. Also, because Share Foundation is a qualifying 501 (c)(3) non profit organization, you can also take a deduction on your federal income tax return as well.
