FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BLANEY...



We don't know for certain how many came to the Leprechaun Hunt® in August. It's hard to figure. But it was raining that morning "cats and dogs" up to noon. People told me they could hardly drive over 20 mph because the rain was so dense. And yet the parking area was filled with cars. I was soaking wet trying to help park cars. But God saw to it that the rain stopped when the hunt started.

Again it was a lot of fun! Many people thanked me for a great time. Kids were heard asking their parents why did they have to leave – they wanted to stay and continue a great time.

There were some crazy rumors about the Leprechauns. One was that the \$1500 leprechaun was hidden under the hay in one of the hay wagons. But halfway through each hunt traditionally, there is no more hay on the wagons. That would be the worst place to put any Leprechaun! Then there was a rumor that our GPS that we use to mark and retrieve the leprechauns that aren't discovered, was some how broken into and people were finding the Leprechauns easily. We have consulted an electronics expert and have been reassured that it is not possible.

There were 7 Leprechauns not found. Last year there were 3. We rarely hide them in the same spots. We try to hide them all over the property but some areas do not have many good hiding places. If a person asks the hay wagon driver to halt, then jumps off, runs into the woods and a few seconds later emerges with a \$500 Leprechaun especially coming out without any scratches on his arms, he had that Leprechaun before he jumped off the wagon. Some people like to appear as a magician! There were no \$500 Leprechauns close to the hay wagon paths.

Our 17th Leprechaun Hunt© was another success with lots of great food, fishing and boating fun, and hay wagon sightseeing plus the lively music and dancing opportunities. It's a lot of work. THOUGHTS FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

The morning of the 17th annual Leprechaun Hunt®, I awoke to cloudy skies and a weather forecast predicting scattered thunderstorms throughout the day. I was filled with apprehension as I drove to Sharing Meadows, wondering how we would ever complete last minute preparations and more importantly, would people come out in the rain to eat the food, enjoy the music and hunt for the leprechauns? We had worked hard for many months planning and preparing and I hoped that our efforts would be rewarded by a big crowd of people and a successful fundraiser.

Amid the threat of rain and skies that were growing darker, we did our best stocking the booths, hanging signs and completing other chores to get ready for the arrival of our guests. The cooks were busy getting the food ready to be served and more volunteers seemed to arrive each minute, all anxious to do whatever was needed. An hour before the official start of the festivities, the thunder cracked and a torrential rain began falling from the sky. We did our best to move things out of the rain but some of the items on display in the booths were soaking wet and needed to be left to dry. People were scurrying around in ponchos and other raingear trying to stay dry but everyone's outlook was bright and even the people waiting for the St. Timothy Center to open were cheerful. After nearly an hour of hard rain and high winds, at one minute before noon, the rain stopped, the sky was clear, and best of all, **the sun was shining!** Bagpiper Kathleen Lang piped Father Blaney up the hill, he blew the golden horn and the festivities were underway!

Once the horn sounded, the hunters were off in search of those elusive leprechauns while those with an appreciation of fine cuisine were enjoying the sumptuous array of food. The Ploughboys began the day's entertainment and from then on, the Irish music never stopped! The Ploughboys were followed by the Doolin Clan and New Element whose performance is always a crown pleaser. The Villagers of Sharing Meadows danced the Irish jig to a standing ovation from the crowd under the tent! Mike Horgash from New Element did a fine job as our auctioneer, raising a record amount in the live auction.

Thousands of people were in attendance, some who've come to every Leprechaun Hunt® and some who were there for the first time. Every one was happy with the food, the entertainment, the hayrides, the fishing and boating, and especially with the people. Our chefs offered something for every taste from tacos and nachos to pulled pork dinners and barbecued ribs and chicken. Marcia Forcey and her crew of Chuck's Shuckers worked nonstop serving 2,000 ears of sweet corn. Hay wagons took our guests all over the property and the laughter coming from the wagons all day assured us that a good time was had by all. Kids had their faces painted by clowns and jumped to their heart's content in the moonwalks. Three and four generations of families came together and enjoyed the day together. Throughout the day people came up to me to express what a great time they were having and to thank us for our efforts in providing such an event.

It was a great celebration and while Father Blaney and the staff and villagers did put in a lot of hours preparing for it, it wouldn't have happened without the hundreds of volunteers who cooked food, parked cars, sold tickets, manned the booths, took care of the moon walk, provided first aid, drove the tractors, supervised the fishing and boating on Tucker Lake and served food, beverages and other treats. The next day, many people came to help with clean up and worked all day in heat and humidity until the grounds looked as good as new! Some of our volunteer cooks worked the entire week prior to the event, delivering food and preparing it for our guest's enjoyment. Our volunteers are the greatest in the world and their dedication and willingness to help truly made a difference!

Leprechaun Hunt 2011 was the best one ever and we are grateful to the many people who supported it in various ways. Now we can look forward to the next exciting family fun day on Sunday, August 5, 2012 when we gather for the 18th annual Leprechaun Hunt®!
