## FROM THE DESK OF FATHER BLANEY...



We are planning to put up 3 more homes in the spring. Already we have villagers waiting to move into the new homes. But we don't have the stewards/house managers. In fact, we are short 2 stewards right now.

A steward/house manager is a live in person five days a week. They supervise the home with 2 villagers, helping them to make good choices, e.g. proper clothes for the day – work or recreation. Many of the good choices are really an affirmation of the choice already made by the villager. And there is help in performing various home duties – fixing meals, cleaning house, washing clothes etc.

Stewards also supervise various work activities if they are on duty during the work days. This could be canning our red raspberry applesauce or baking apple pies, weaving, ceramics, mowing the grass, woodworking etc. A steward working on the weekends would instigate recreational activities, e.g. hiking, bicycling, going to a movie or a festival etc.

If you or someone you know has already supervised the growth of their children and has the ability of continuing that growth of a human being, this would be a fantastic job.

Did I mention that there is a salary? And did I mention that our stewards are off for a week at Thanksgiving, two weeks at Christmas and a week at Easter? All this with pay. You could still have quality time with your family on the high holidays.

If you are shortly out of college and still not settled into the big job, this is a place for you. Here you can fine tune a sense of responsibility – an awareness of other people's feelings – a genuine sense of self affirmation that comes when you help another person who appreciates the help and appreciates you as a person. There is room & board, health insurance, a bonus after a year of service and the opportunity of meeting many first class people.

God has been so good to us in allowing us to witness the resplendent growth of our villagers and now we will be blessed to witness it again with others!

In the 20 years since we first purchased the land, we have watched it develop from 185 acres of farmland into a loving Christian community. With your continued help, we know we can continue the movement and build the final village. You will be receiving a letter asking for your generous support and we pray that you will answer our call like you have done in the past and help us in the development of Sharing Meadows. Your gift – large or small – truly makes a difference! We have had a few struggles over the years but the hard times are overshadowed by the peace, the success, the joy and the love that abounds here and we want that to continue. The villagers realize what a good place this is and they want others to know the same joy that they experience each and every day.

Our prayers of Thanksgiving extend to all of you who have helped us come so far and we ask God to bless you with the same peace that fills our community. The success of our Capital Fund Drive will enable us to build the next village without a mortgage and your prayers and encouragement give us hope as we continue to grow. 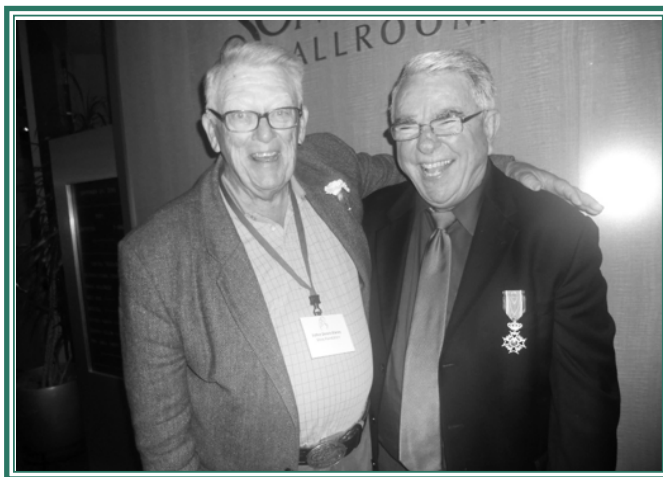
